On **Monday 14th December**, Year 6 will be attending a **Big Day Out** to reward their achievements as leaders and role models in the school and celebrate their time at Dulwich Hill PS as a whole. The children will be travelling by light rail to Darling Harbour where they will be taking part in two games of laser skirmish and a game of ten-pin bowling at **Kingpin Bowling Lounge**, Level 3 Harbourside Shopping Centre.

After these activities, the children will be having lunch. If your child would like to purchase their lunch from the food court at Harbourside, they will need to bring their own money to do so. If not, they will need to bring their own lunch. After lunch, we will be spending approx. an hour on the play equipment at Darling Harbour before heading back to school. We will be returning to school by 3:15pm.



- VENUE:** Kingpin Bowling Lounge, Darling Harbour
- DATE:** Monday 14th December 2020
- TIMES:** Student will need to be at school by **9:15am**. Children will return to school by **3:15pm**.
- TRANSPORT:** Light Rail (all students will need to bring their own OPAL card with sufficient credit to travel to and from Darling Harbour)
- RECESS & LUNCH:** Recess and lunch **IS NOT** provided. Students will need to bring their own recess and lunch and/or bring money to purchase their lunch from the Harbourside Shopping Centre food court.
- COST:** \$25 (This cost has been added to your term 4 invoice)
- SUPERVISION:** Mr John Nguyen, Ms Baker & Ms Condon
- WHAT TO WEAR:** Students will NOT be required to wear school uniform. However, they will be running around as part of the activities and need to wear appropriate clothing and enclosed footwear.
